**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY MAINTENANCE WORKS  
M69 Junction 1 to M1 Junction 21**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential safety maintenance works on the M69 between Junction 1 and Junction 21 of the M1. During this work, we will be upgrading the Vehicle Restraint System in the central reserve.

**When will the work take place?**

Our work is due to start on **28<sup>th</sup> July 2022** and is scheduled for completion by **end October 2022**. To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise inconvenience and disruption to the local community, residents and road users, we will work between **8pm** and **6am Monday to Friday**.

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions, significant events or unforeseen circumstances.

**How will the work affect traffic?**

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and road users, we will need to close some lanes however at least 1 lane will be kept running at all times. Where the M69 is used as a diversion route for other roads, we will ensure that two lanes are kept open.
