



Dear Sir / Madam,

I am writing to inform you that our Croft Quarry will undertake a controlled blast during the week commencing 24th August, in order to demolish a disused structure in a fast, safe manner.

This is scheduled for Thursday; although this may take place on Wednesday or Friday depending on the conditions on the day.

A further blast will be conducted during the week commencing 31st August at a location lower down in the quarry.

We recognise that the planned demolition that took place on Wednesday 19th August at Croft caused disturbance to some residents within the local area and we apologise for the concerns this raised. The prevailing weather conditions (in particular low cloud) and location of the charges on site (attached to the base of the structure rather than in a drilled hole as is the case in quarry blasting) contributed to the effects being heard and felt more significantly and further afield than usual. The larger window for next week's main blast will allow us to conduct the demolition when conditions are favourable.

While we had communicated our plans with the district council and Croft and Huncote parish councils, we recognise that this was not sufficient, and we hope this letter will provide you with adequate warning ahead of the forthcoming works.
